- □ An official high school transcript -- if you do not have a posted Associates' degree, the AGEC or the California IGETC.
- ACT and/or SAT scores. You should indicate NAU as a score recipient when you register for either test.
 (Please note: the essay portion of either the ACT or SAT will not be considered in the admissions decision process.)
 NAU ACT code: 0086; NAU SAT code: 4006. Test scores posted to your official high school transcript are accepted.

TRANSFER STUDENT ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

If you have earned more than 12 college credit hours after graduating from high school or earning your General Equivalency Diploma (GED), you are a transfer student.

ARIZONA RESIDENTS:

Arizona residents will be **offered** admission if they have completed an Associate's degree, the AGEC, or the California IGETC.

Arizona residents will also be **offered** admission if they have a 2.50 or higher GPA (on a 4.0 scale) in at least 24 transferable college credits **and** completion of all the required college preparatory courses (listed at right).

Arizona residents will be **considered** for admission if they have a 2.50 or higher GPA (on a 4.0 scale) in at least 24 transferable college credits **and** have no more than one deficiency in any two subject areas in the required college preparatory courses (listed at right). Students with a combination of math and lab science deficiency are not admissible.

NON-RESIDENTS:

Non-resident transfer students will be **offered** admission if they have completed an Associate's degree, the AGEC, or the California IGETC.

Non-residents will also be **offered** admission if they have a 2.50 or higher GPA (on a 4.0 scale) in at least 24 transferable college credits **and** if they have completed all the required college preparatory courses (listed at right).

Non-resident transfer students will be **considered** for admission based on individual circumstances and/or space availability if they have a 2.00 or higher GPA (on a 4.0 scale) in at least 24 transferable college credits and have no more than one deficiency in any two subject areas in the the required college preparatory courses (listed below). Students with a combination of math and lab science deficiency are not admissible.

PLEASE NOTE:

Transfer students who do not have a posted associate's degree, the AGEC or the California IGETC are offered admission based on both their college and high school records, and the grades received. These students need a minimum of a 2.00 GPA in each of the required college prepatory courses (listed below) to be offered admission.

COLLEGE PREPARATORY COURSES:

- 4 years of college preparatory English
- 4 years of Math, including Algebra I & II, Geometry and any advanced math course for which Algebra II is a prerequisite
- 3 years of laboratory Science one in three of the four areas of Biology, Chemistry, Physics, Earth Science
- 2 years of Social Science one year must be American History
- 2 years of one Foreign Language
- 1 year of Fine Arts
