

## **COURSE DESCRIPTION**

This entry-level professional development course is designed to prepare tribal staff to conduct a variety of air quality education and outreach activities that will help tribal members increase the public awareness about environmental issues and increase tribal members' abilities to make informed decisions that improve environmental air quality. Tribal staff will learn that environmental air quality education is a process that allows individuals to explore environmental issues, engage in problem solving, and take action to improve the environment. As a result, individuals develop a deeper understanding of air quality, environmental issues and have the skills to make informed and responsible decisions. Course participants will experience environmental education tools and curricula that can be used in formal and informal educational settings.
