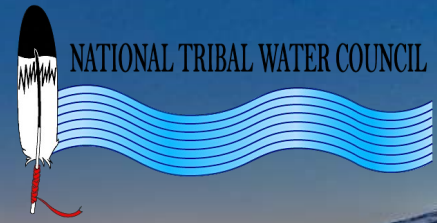


TRIBAL WATER QUALITY STANDARDS GUIDEBOOK WEBINAR
